

## El Dorado County ARC Weekly Net Script

Good evening everyone and welcome to the El Dorado County Amateur Radio Club's weekly net. I am your net control station this evening, \_\_\_\_\_ and my name is \_\_\_\_\_. This net meets each Tuesday at 7:30 pm. The purpose of the net is to exchange information pertaining to amateur radio and club activities. For this net we are using the AG6AU repeater located at Camino, California about 50 miles east of Sacramento along Hwy 50. The repeater operates on a frequency of 147.825 MHz with a PL of 82.5.

You do not have to be a member of the El Dorado County Amateur Radio Club to participate in this net. All amateurs are welcome; however, it is suggested that members of the club be allowed check-in first. We ask that you check-in alphabetically according to the first letter of your call sign suffix. When checking in, please give your call sign, your first name, and then your location. Once the membership has had an opportunity to check-in any visitors will be invited and encouraged to check-in as well.

**\*\* Before we begin, is there any emergency or priority traffic? \*\***

*(Acknowledge and handle the traffic, ask for assistance if necessary.)*

Hearing none, will member stations with call sign suffix ALPHA through DELTA please check in now.

I copied \_\_\_\_\_. Are there any missed stations ALPHA through DELTA?

Member stations with call sign suffix ECHO through LIMA please check in now.

I copied \_\_\_\_\_. Are there any missed stations ECHO through LIMA?

Member stations with call sign suffix MIKE through ROMEO please check in now.

I copied \_\_\_\_\_. Are there any missed stations MIKE through ROMEO?

Member stations with call sign suffix SIERRA through ZULU please check in now.

I copied \_\_\_\_\_. Are there any missed stations SIERRA through ZULO?

Are there any late or missed member stations ALPHA through ZULU?

We now invite visitors who are listening to please check-in by giving your call sign, your name and your location. *(Ask if they are visiting or new to area, and if they have checked into our net before. Then welcome them and thank them for checking in.)*

Does any station have any announcements, reports, information or traffic for the net tonight?

*(Now is the time to bring up any interesting topics for discussion, i.e. amateur radio news, new equipment, interesting DX, or a good joke.)*

Now each station will have a moment to comment on their amateur radio activities or items for discussion.

*(Call on each station by the order in which they checked in, and ask for comments)*

This is the last call for check-ins of members or visitors. *(Ask if they have any comments.)*

Does any station have any further information or comments for the net?

*(Acknowledge each station if any?)*

Hearing no stations with further information let me say on behalf of the EL Dorado County Amateur Radio Club that we appreciate your continued support and interest in the repeater and the net. Remember to join us at our monthly meetings occurring the 4<sup>th</sup> Thursday of each month at 7:15 pm at the Federated Church in Placerville. I will now close the net at \_\_\_\_\_.
